"Best Behavior Policy" The four B's After School

KYDS is committed to the safety and well-being of our students, and is committed to creating a safe, productive environment so your child can learn and have fun after school. This requires that students commit to bringing their best to after school time, just as everyone strives to do during the school day.

Auditorium	Enter and leave single file. Walk at all times. Wait for dismissal instructions.	Sit quietly. Listen actively. No food or drinks.	Listen attentively. Keep hands and feet to yourself. Participate when asked.
Cell Phone	Cell phones/gaming/internet browsing devices must remain in backpack.	Cell phone usage/gaming device usage/internet browsing/taking photos/posting to social media is not permitted.	Phone calls to parents should be made with the site coordinator.

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KYDS staff are always on the lookout for students following the four B's after school and focus on positively acknowledging students demonstrating the four B's.

It is our priority to maintain an environment that is safe, positive and nurturing. With this goal in mind, students and their parents are expected to conduct themselves appropriately and may lose the opportunity to participate in KYDS or the privilege to stay afterschool altogether if their conduct is harmful to others or disruptive.

When such incidents occur KYDS staff will inform school day administration and issue a Written Warning, Behavior Contract or Loss of Privilege.

Late pick up policy: KYDS closes promptly at 6PM (unless otherwise indicated on the activity calendar).

Parents are requested to contact KYDS site coordinator if a child cannot be picked up by 6pm. Excessive late pick up can result in a loss of privilege to stay after school for the remainder of a semester. Excessive late pick up is defined as being late more than 3 times in the school year. Our staff will make every effort to contact the parent or the persons listed as emergency contacts. If we are unable to make contact by 7PM, the local police will be contacted, and the child will be taken to the local police station.

KYDS staff is not allowed to take children home.
